

The 117° West location is the premium TV neighborhood for Latin America, offering panregional distribution of major networks and content providers. With an extremely strong cable head-end penetration, top pay-TV operators in Latin America receive their content from 117° West.

Around 500 TV channels, 150 in HD, are currently distributed to over 100 million TV homes across the continent. 117° West is also a growing free-to-air TV neighborhood with 140 TV channels broadcasting in the clear, including channels from key regional public and private broadcasters.


With spectrum availability in the higher 200 MHz of C-band, bandwidth is not affected by the FCC 5G Auction.


