
The turnkey service combines ground services (including contribution links, content multiplexing and uplinking) and satellite bandwidth, for cost-effective access to large established audiences.




HOTBIRD at 13° East


AFRICA (French-Speaking)

- Home to pay-TV platforms in the Indian Ocean region: Canal+ International, Orange and Parabole Réunion


BRAZIL EUTELSAT 65 West at 65° West
